Founded in 1975, Urban Pathways provides homeless New Yorkers with the services and assistance necessary to become stable develop their ability to live independently and move into housing, ultimately benefiting from the pride and security that comes with having a home. We are currently seeking a solid Program Director for a Safe Haven Program in Brooklyn, NY.

The Safe Haven Program Director administers and oversees an environment focused on providing consumer access to the facility and program through engagement and a low threshold oriented approach. S/he has oversight of all Safe Haven staff members and will assure the delivery of all services coordinating with the Program Management Team, respective staff, and working to resolve problems as they emerge. S/he will be responsible for the development, implementation and assessment of program policies, practices and procedures governing casework practice with Administrative Staff. S/he will develop, implement and assess a range of appropriate therapeutic, rehabilitative, vocational and recreational services reflecting the interests, social requirements, and disabilities of clients. S/he will conduct case conferences as necessary with clients; be available to clients and responsive to their concerns; assist with client crises. S/he will design, implement, and monitor a system of service plan reviews to assure qualitative and quantitative accountability with respect to clients.

QUALIFICATIONS: Masters in Social Work, Psychology, or Rehabilitation with at least five (5) years of supervisory and/or administrative experience at the Supervisor or Director level in a shelter or Community Residence setting for homeless, mentally ill, or substance abuse populations.
